Find out as much as you can about the company

EXPLAIN YOUR EXAMPLES IN DETAIL

Use the S.T.A.R. method to answer questions*

> LOOK YOUR BEST

Your clothes should be neat and appropriate for the working environment You should be well-groomed No heavy perfume or cologne Modest jewelry

BE PREPARED

Bring a copy of your resume, references, samples of work if appropriate

> ARRIVE EARLY

Make sure you know how to get to the interview and arrive 10 minutes early

*The S.T.A.R. Method:

Situation

Explain the situation

Task

Explain your task or role

Action

What action did you take?

Results

What resulted from your action?



Commonly asked interview questions:

- * Tell me a little about yourself
- What are your strengths?
- * What are your weaknesses?
- * Why do you want to work here?
- * Tell me about your most recent job.
- * Why did you leave your last job?

BODY LANGUAGE

Look the interviewer in the eye, but don't stare Sit up straight and act alert Don't chew gum or smoke Smile when appropriate

BE ENTHUSIASTIC

Show genuine interest in the job

USE DISCRETION

Be honest in your answers but steer away from troublesome areas

> ASK QUESTIONS

Ask questions that will help you decide if the position is suitable for you

> SUBJECTS TO AVOID:

Don't mention financial or personal problems Don't talk about what was wrong with previous employers Don't mention salary or benefits

> REMEMBER TO THANK YOUR INTERVIEWER
